<u>Minutes:</u> A motion to approve the minutes was made by Joe Saum, 2nd by Chelsea Moore, all in favor, motion carried, to approve and accept the Minutes of the Meeting on May 27, 2025.

Mike Smith-Police Academy: Did not pass his physical so he was not able to start the Academy in July. He will possibly start in January.

250th Celebration Meeting Update: Chelsea attended the meeting and stated they are looking for volunteers to serve on committees for the Celebration. The grant they applied for was denied and they are working a list of businesses to send letters to for donations. They are hoping to get committees together to meet before the next meeting in October. Eric also attended the meeting and had some concerns about the timing of events.

<u>USPS Renewal Agreement for Approval:</u> The renewal will begin in 2027 for a 5-year term. A motion to renew the lease was made by Joe Saum, 2nd by Eric Pelc, all in favor, motion carried.

Fire Co & Disaster Plans: Pete wanted to Thank the Fire Company and Tyler Weikert for all they did during the power outage. Pete is working on a committee to come up with disaster plans details. He would like to see the Fire Co get a generator to use for an emergency. They would need the Borough to apply for the grant. Council agreed and told Pete to work on getting the process started. Council also wants to talk to Josh Fitting about possibly joining the NAREMA group.

<u>Property on Quarry Rd:</u> Several inquiries about this property and the cost to connect to water and sewer which is part in Menallen Township and the Borough. After much discussion, Council agreed they can connect but at the property owners expense.

<u>Pay Bills and Treasurer's Report:</u> A motion by Eric Pelc, 2nd by Joe Saum, all in favor, motion carried, to pay bills dated July 1, 2025, and accept the treasurer's report.
